AUBURN- Eugene "Gene" Tardif, 79, of Lewiston died Sunday, October 30, 2016 at the Hospice House of Androscoggin following a brief illness.

He was born in Lewiston, Maine on January 15, 1937 the son of the late Leonidas and Aldenard (Vallee) Tardif and had been a resident of this community all of his life. He was educated in Lewiston schools and was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force. He owned and operated Top Hat Café on Lisbon Street in Lewiston for many years. He then was employed as a custodian in the Lewiston school system until his retirement. He had been very active and was president of the MSEA SEIU 1989 Local 5 Chapter, president of the Webber Avenue Club in Lewiston and a parishioner of Holy Cross Church.
