Greene – Michael Anthony King, 80, of Greene, Maine passed away peacefully on February 13, 2020 at home. He was born in Mechanic Falls, Maine, on September 1, 1939, the son of Edward and Grace (Hartford) King and was educated in Lewiston schools. In his early twenties, he was employed as a press operator at Geiger Brothers. In later years, he worked at Lewiston Shoe Machinery building industrial sewing machines. For a time, Mike also owned and operated King's Sewing Machine Repair.

In 1972, Mike became involved with harness racing, which became his fondest hobby. He was a member of the United States Trotting Association and the Maine Harness Horsemen's Association.
