He was an Army veteran during the Korean Conflict.

In 1978 he began his real estate career, which had been such a big part of his life. He worked at ERA Worden Reality until he co-founded "Murphy and Clavette Reality" with Lorraine Clavette in 1982. The company flourished, and Dick was loved and respected. In the eighties, his daughter Maureen joined a workforce of 15. Smart, business minded, devoted to helping others, worked tirelessly, without counting his time.
