LEWISTON - Ronald M Bellemore born 5/21/1954 in Berlin N.H. and who lived on Paul Street in Lewiston passed away peacefully with his family at his side on Saturday August 10th after a four month battle with colon cancer.

He was the son of the late Roland and Mae (Downes) Bellemore. He attended Berlin High School class of 1972 and then continued his education at the University of New Hampshire; he finally completed his degree work at the University of Southern Maine in 2000 while working full time and raising his family.

His chosen career was in healthcare materials management; he worked for 37 yrs at St. Mary's Regional Medical Center where over time he had become the director of Materials Management. Later he went to work for Martin's Point Health Care as the manager of their Materials department, which does purchasing for their various physician groups. He had the pleasure of meeting and getting to know hundreds of wonderful people over those years.
